Points of interest from last week's meeting:

Planning Inquiry

The inquiry for the Gatley Golf Club planning appeal has closed. Cllr Charles-Jones asked the planning officer for an update as to when we were likely to hear the result, the council have no indication of timescales.

GMP

Sgt Matt Delaney gave an update from the police:

- There has been a continued reduction in burglaries, for November Heald Green, Cheadle and Bramhall has the lowest number in Stockport division.
- GMP are working proactively on a number of initiatives, including operation Intercept, with Cheshire police to tackle burglaries.
- There will be a campaign against drink and drug driving over the Christmas period.
- People are encouraged to think about their home security such as light timer switches over the Christmas period, when there is often an uptick in burglaries.
- There have been issues with cannabis being ordered from abroad, which is illegal.
- Pavement parking in Heald Green is something the police have been addressing
- The police have upped patrols in response to anti-social behaviour, particularly near the Beech Tree pub site on Outwood Rd, as ever the police need intelligence to support their work.
- Retail crime prevention is also something they have been working on with retailers.
- The PACT meetings have been a good opportunity for engagement and discussion of issues.
