Update from Highways Meeting

Councillors recently held their regular meeting with officers to discuss all issues related to Highways, items raised were:

Flooding

Following the significant and damaging flood event on 1 January 2025 a Section 19 report will be compiled. This will seek to understand the cause of the flooding and learn any lessons regarding the council's response, and how this can be improved for the future. It will also consider actions that may be needed to mitigate future problems.

Officers have emphasised it is very important that anyone whose property was impacted by flooding should report this to the council, so it can be included in the study. Please pass this on to anyone you know who suffered from flooding. The contact details are here:

Traffic Regulation Orders

Following the consultation in the Greenway Road and surrounding areas officers are looking at all comments received and plans are being drawn up to extend the double yellow lines, these will go to the Cheadle Area Committee for decision in March.

Officers are going to carry out observations of the Griffin Farm / Wilmslow Road junction, as residents are reporting difficulties exiting due to cars parking close to the junction.

The junction of Elmsleigh Road and Styal Road has gone to Legal Services for sign off.

Similarly, the Styal Road / Brown Lane consultation has been completed and plans are also being drawn up for Cheadle Area Committee.

Changes to Formby Drive and Finney Lane are awaiting sign off from Legal Services.

The lines opposite The Griffin have been scheduled for repainting.

Gateway Signs

This longstanding issue is unfortunately not yet resolved, an issue has arisen with the quote for the works, which is being clarified. It will take 16 weeks to manufacture the signs. So this remains some way off completion. We have raised the frustration of residents about this.

Outwood Drive

Officers are drawing up plans to look at installing a one way system to respond to the significant problems of people parking and blocking the junction with Finney Lane.

We have received a request to relocate one of the bins from near the War Memorial to near the junction because of the significant problems with litter here. Officers will look into whether this would be possible.

Car Park

The car park by The Heald Green is due for resurfacing soon, notices will be posted prior to the works taking place.

Library / Health Centre

The faded signage here for the car park was raised with officers, as it needs to be replaced.
